

## STRENGTHENING FAMILIES



In Lemuel, we regard the family as the foundation of all sustainable development. Without strong families, poverty deepens. And without strong families, our work will not last beyond one generation. It is imperative, therefore, that we do all we can to support, encourage, and strengthen the families of our community.



While our Water Solutions and Temporary Work programs certainly play a role in strengthening families, there are additional ways that we are able to provide a handup for families. Keep in mind that all of these projects fall under the Community Development objective of addressing the needs of our community in ways that maintain dignity and encourage unity and hard work. This means that we do not simply step in and "do for" these families, but rather we look to them to take initiative and do what they can. Then we come alongside them and "do with" them.

- 1. Improve sanitation by helping families build latrines
- 2. Support families as they build concrete homes with metal roofs
- 3. Alleviate water shortages by helping families build cisterns
- 4. Invest in micro-business efforts that bring is supplemental income for the family

5. Facilitate families in fencing in their property so that they can plant trees and crops in their yard. Without a fence, free-range livestock make these efforts impossible

- 6. Encourage education through affordable tuition and advanced study programs
- 7. Teach God's will for families in Sunday services and through relationships.
